Genealogical Proof Standard Components & Context

- Reasonably exhaustive research ensures examination of <u>all potentially relevant sources</u>. It minimizes the risk that undiscovered evidence will overturn a too-hasty conclusion.
- Complete and accurate source citations
- Critical tests of relevant evidence through processes of analysis and correlation
- Resolution of conflicting evidence
- Soundly reasoned, coherently written conclusion

- Research Phase
 - Laws & history inform us about events that shaped subjects' lives
 - Clues help solve difficult cases of identity and kinship
- Writing [& Presentation] Phases
 - Add human interest
 - To encourage and invite audience interaction & feedback

- Connected directly to ancestors' lives

- Woven into the narrative rather than footnotes
